

CAMPBELLTOWN ANGLICAN YOUTH

Online Video Conference Expectations

1. Communication

Campbelltown Anglican Youth online will be run:

- a. from 7-8:15pm of Friday nights during school term;
- b. the platform being used will be Zoom;
- c. only authorised leaders and youth will be involved in the meeting;
- d. each video conference will be recorded for Safe Ministry requirements. Only authorised personnel of Campbelltown Anglican Churches will have access as requested if investigations are needed.

2. Permission

- a. Permission is to be given by the parent/carer for Youth to access online meetings.

3. On Screen Activity

a. Video

All participants are expected to dress modestly and be mindful of what is in their video. If an individual's video is deemed inappropriate, they will be reminded of the expectations. If it is not able to be rectified, their video will be disabled.

b. Language

All participants are expected to speak in a respectful manner. If there is any inappropriate language, the individual will be reminded of this online video conference expectation. If there is continued inappropriate language, the individual will be muted or in extreme circumstances they may be removed from the meeting.

c. Location

Within the limitations of physical distancing, individuals are to situate themselves in a public space of their household (e.g. living room) for online video conferencing. We ask that video conferencing is not to be accessed in bedrooms or other private locations. If you are unable to be in a public area, we ask that you turn off your camera to abide by safe ministry requirements.

d. Screen Share

Youth are not to share their screen during the online video conferencing.

e. Virtual Background

All participants are expected to be respectful and appropriate in their use of virtual backgrounds. If it is deemed inappropriate by a youth leader, they will be asked to remove it.

f. Chat

All participants are expected to use the chat function in a respectful manner.
